Afghans in a shelter can be shy and afraid. They don't like barking and alot of noise. They may seem to be aggressive with people or other dogs. They generally don't like their feet touched.

More then likely will be matted or shaved.

Please let one of our volunteers come evaluate the dog before euthanzing.

Colors: black, blk & tan/white, cream, white red, brindle, any of these can have black masks, also blue, domino (like pup on front blue/cream)
